The CSNA Library

Your CSNA Library contains more than 1,300 volumes on numismatics of all eras and all parts of the world, including hundreds of out-of-print books. It is one of CSNA's most important educational resources and a major benefit of membership.

The Library was established when CSNA was organized in 1947 as one of the association's key educational functions. The first Librarian, Stewart J. Bingham, served 1947 to 1961.

Mrs. Eldon (Dorothy) Beaulieu served as Librarian from 1961 into the 1990s. When she retired, plans to relocate and recatalog the library moved slowly until 2002, when Ruth Phillips agreed to take over the position.

Ruth moved the CSNA Library into her home and arranged its unpacking and shelving. She worked with other members to have the catalog computerized so that a catalog and web pages showing the Library's contents can be kept current and available to all members.

When Ruth resigned in 2010, the CSNA Library was moved to Vallejo, CA, by then-President Michael S. Turrini, where it has now been made available to all members.

The Web Library Catalog

The modern catalog is available on CSNA's website (www.calcoin.org).

To view titles via computer, go to the CSNA website at www.calcoin.org. Open the Library page and use either the Acrobat PDF file or the subject links. Browse the subjects which interest you or download the complete catalog and print any parts you require.

Most public libraries have computers available for members who do not have Internet access.

How to Use the Library

All titles in the CSNA Library are available to CSNA *members in good standing* as follows:

1. Members must contact the CSNA Librarian to request books.
2. The Librarian will confirm that the person making the request is a current member of CSNA, and then proceed with preparing the book loan.
3. The period of the loan for each title will be shown on a checkout sheet, which will include return shipping instructions.
4. Members will return the books on time and insure them for the amount indicated on the checkout sheet.
5. Members will enclose payment for the shipping/insurance used in sending them the books when returning them.
